

(Re)Schedule Comments



- When will we really start the Heidelberg Slice Test programme?
- ◆ At the June Mainz meeting, slippage during previous 4 months had been >3 months
 - **♦** Reasons suggested then were:
 - Designing prototypes "to Module 0 specification" was very challenging extra time needed for the detailed designs
 - Strong tendency to under-estimate times
- ◆ Slippage since then (during last 4 months) has only been ~2 months!



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- ◆ The big unknown is the duration of the sub-system commissioning phase
 - ♦ Is 3 months realistic remembering the long duration of the ROD tests?
 - With the hardware designs mostly complete, time estimates are much more predictable (layout, manufacture, assembly)
 - ◆ Software readiness is still a worry ...
- ◆ There is now a good chance that we will be ready by Summer 2002 ...
- Remember that the outcome of the Slice Test programme will determine the PRR phase for production of the trigger
- ◆ Therefore its scope must be very carefully pre-defined
 - **♦** To demonstrate clearly that the system is feasible
 - ◆ To limit its duration not completely open-ended
