Product Description

Adobe Acrobat 2.1 software, a family of universal electronic publishing tools, allows users to create rich, dynamic electronic documents that can be distributed on the broadest range of electronic media including the World Wide Web, E-mail, Lotus® Notes®, corporate networks, CD-ROM and print-on-demand systems. The Adobe Portable Document Format (PDF), an open-cross platform file format created by Acrobat software, preserves the fidelity of documents across a wide variety of computer platforms, printers and electronic distribution methods. Acrobat 2.1 software offers enhancements to facilitate World Wide Web publishing and integrating multimedia elements into Acrobat files. Adobe Acrobat 2.1 software is available for Windows, Macintosh and UNIX® systems.

Expanded Platform support

Weblink: World Wide Web Publishing Tool

Weblink is a plug-in application for Acrobat software that connects PDF files to other documents anywhere on the World Wide Web. Authors can embed a Universal Resource Locator (URL) within a PDF file, allowing viewers to connect to other documents on the Internet. Weblink is available for Macintosh, Windows and UNIX versions of Acrobat 2.1 software.

Movie tool: Authoring Tool for Creating Interactive Documents

Users can now easily incorporate multimedia elements into PDF files with Movie tool, a plug-in application that supports QuickTime TM and AVI video and audio files. In addition, Movie tool allows users to specify the placement and layout of a digital video file and the way it will be displayed. Movie tool is available for Macintosh and Windows versions of Acrobat 2.1 software.
